• Will need minimum of 15 people per week

Dad fest | June 16th | 1:00pm to 6:00pm

Will need minimum of 5 people on Sunday

Jazz Festival | September 7th | 1:00pm to 9:00pm

• Will need minimum of 5 people on Saturday

- Provide Non-Profit Certification 501©3
- Provide proof of General Liability insurance
- Agree to the terms and conditions
- Provide organization-branded jar/container(s) for tips collections
- Applicants may submit their application to tversocki@albanyny.gov

- All volunteers must be 18 years or older to serve alcohol
- The City of Albany reserves the right to review and approve any and all marketing/advertising items pertaining to any and all of the events described above
- The City's selection of a nonprofit volunteer organization for these events will be based on the following criteria: (1) the organizations understanding of the guidelines and requirements; (2) the organizations ability to provide the minimum requirements that are asked within the application
